These rules are to be read in conjunction with IPSC Handgun Competition Rules Jan 2009, and all Handgun Rules are applicable except for the following UKPSA amendments and additions.

Rule 4.3

All references to IPSC , mini , pepper and classic poppers are Not Applicable

Rule 5.1.2

Minimum calibre is .22RF. (See appendices for specific division requirements)

Rule 5.2.7.2

A holster with the heel of the butt of the handgun below the bottom of the belt.

Rule 5.2.8

Not applicable

Rule 5.2.8.1

Remains applicable.

Additional Rule 5.6.4.

.22RF divisions will not be subject to chronograph testing.

Appendix C3.

Add.. Metal plates may be of similar shape , but may vary from IPSC quoted sizes. Their construction may also be of metal and other materials or may be of materials other than metal.

18. Neither the handgun, nor any of its attachments, nor any allied equipment (e.g. magazines or other loading devices), can extend forward of the line illustrated in Appendix F3. Any such items a Range Officer deems not to be in compliance must be safely and promptly adjusted, failing which Rule 6.2.5.1 will apply.
