



UKPSA HANDGUN RULES

1. Treat all guns and equipment with due care & respect – if you damage it, or something is not working, please tell Jim Bowman in the shop! That way we can fix it so it's ready for the next person to use! You will not be charged for damage, things happen, it's not a problem, but if you fail to report it, we can't do anything about it!
2. Only factory ammunition can be used in the UKPSA guns – NO HOME LOADS, NO EXCEPTIONS!
3. When you have finished using a gun, clean and oil it, ready for the next person. A cleaning kit is provided with every gun. If you fail to clean the gun, you will be charged a £10 cleaning fee! If you don't know how to disassemble and clean the particular gun – ASK!
4. Only current UKPSA members can use the UKPSA Guns, they are allocated on a first come first served basis and cannot be reserved for a particular day/competition. However, they can be shared! Please be sensible and work with your fellow UKPSA members.
5. All shooters at NITSA must be accompanied by a member with a Full-Bore Competition Licence or a Range officer or an Instructor/Club Coach – one of you must be designated the RO and wear a fluorescent jacket which can be borrowed from the Range Shop. You can swap roles during your training session as much as you like.
6. All shooters must read and comply with the NITSA range safety rules which will be explained to you by a member of the NITSA staff.

Important Note on Legalities:

To shoot at NITSA as a Visitor from the UK you have to be a member of a Home Office Approved Club as well as a UKPSA member. If you are not you can still go, but it has to be on an authorised Guest Day.
